“Senator Landrieu, We Await Your Answer”

Open video and letter released requesting Sen. Landrieu’s answer on abortion in health care

Baton Rouge, LA- On Wednesday, the Louisiana Right to Life Federation and Louisiana Family Forum Action, in conjunction with numerous organizations, including Family Research Council and its President Tony Perkins, released an open letter and video requesting that Senator Landrieu answer the following question:



“Will you commit to the citizens of Louisiana to actively oppose any health care proposal unless it explicitly forbids the government involvement in the funding of abortion and the mandating of abortion coverage?”

Gene Mills, President of Louisiana Family Forum Action, stated, “At last Thursday’s Town Hall in Reserve, a similar question was asked to Senator Landrieu. The senator neglected to answer the question directly. While many of us differ on the specifics of health care reform, we have united to ask Senator Landrieu to publically answer this essential question.”

Benjamin Clapper, Director of Louisiana Right to Life Federation, remarked, “Our own extensive research and recent media reports have clearly shown that abortion will be directly funded by our government unless language is included in health care reform legislation that explicitly excludes abortion funding. If legislation is passed without this language, our government would directly fund abortion on demand for the first time since 1976. As the Senator of a pro-life state, we need Senator Landrieu to answer our question.”
